## New Jersey Cottey Fund Guidelines for Transportation Grants

It is not the New Jersey Cottey Committee's responsibility to evaluate the qualifications of a possible Cottey student, but rather to discern whether a student is seriously considering enrolling at Cottey College and to disburse funds as a reimbursement for a Cottey recruitment visit. Not every student who visits Cottey enrolls or even applies, but attendance at an officially sponsored and/or sanctioned Cottey recruitment event will be considered serious interest and therefore eligible for transportation reimbursement.

The amount of the grant awarded will be determined by the New Jersey Cottey Committee. There is no set amount awarded. Grants are not intended to fully cover expenses.

The grant is applicable for a visit to Cottey College in Nevada, MO for an admissions recruitment event sponsored and/or sanctioned by the college. Dates of these events are posted on the Cottey web site (www.cottey.edu)

Applications for reimbursement can be obtained by contacting a member of the New Jersey State Cottey Committee (see the 'Directory of State Officers and Committees' for contact info) and should be mailed to the address listed on the form. The application for the scholarship must be received by the committee within one month before or after the visit and must be accompanied by appropriate receipts for actual travel expenses. The student will be notified immediately of receipt of application materials.

Approved grants will be paid upon return from the visit and verification of attendance by the Cottey Admissions Office.
